

Imrich Chlamtac received his Ph.D. in Computer Science from the University of Minnesota (1979), followed by a faculty position at Technion, Israel Institute of Technology. He currently holds the Distinguished Chair in Telecommunications Professorship at the University of Texas at Dallas, which he joined in January 1997 to develop joint networking initiatives between the University and the Telecom Corridor, the largest concentration of telecommunications firms in the world.

In 2000 Dr. Chlamtac was awarded the Bruno Kessler Professorship from the University of Trento, Italy. Dr. Chlamtac is currently on part time leave from UTD as Founder and President of CREATE-NET, the international research consortium in networking and telecommunications.
